Getting to Decatur/Where to park

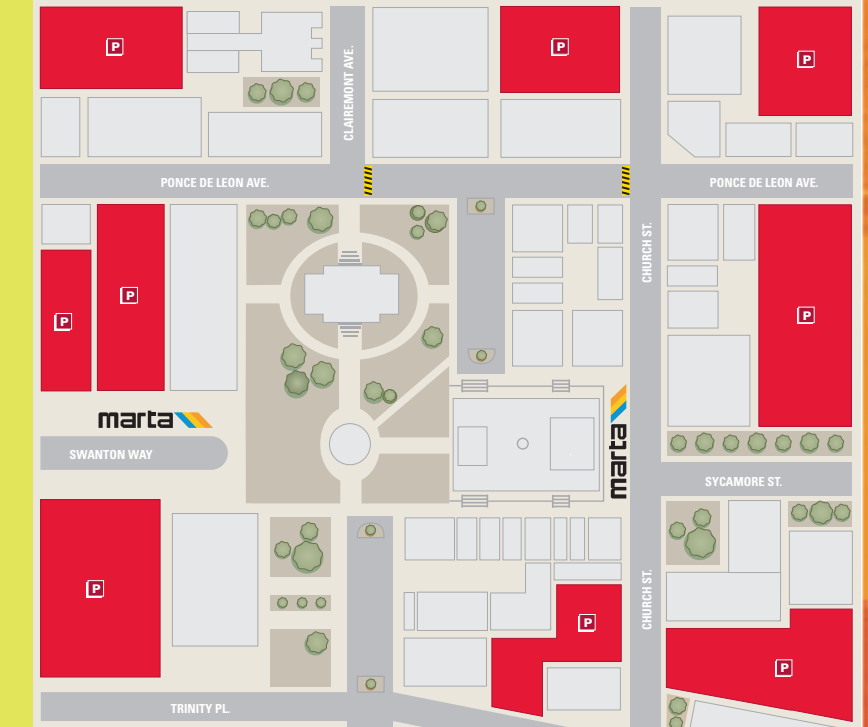
Public parking lots are marked in red

From Downtown Atlanta: Go east on Ponce de Leon Ave. Merge right onto W. Ponce de Leon Ave. and proceed into downtown Decatur.

From I-85 N: Take exit 91 south and continue on Clairemont Ave. into downtown Decatur.

From I-285 E/S: Take exit 39A to merge into U.S. 78 W. toward Decatur/Atlanta. Merge left onto Church St. and continue south to Ponce De Leon Ave.

From I-20 E: Take exit 65 (Candler Rd.) north to Decatur. Cross the railroad tracks, take a slight left onto Trinity Ave. to N. McDonough St.



The Decatur MARTA station is at the center of the festival grounds.
